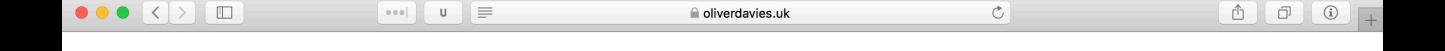

Since starting to work with Laravel as well as Drupal and Symfony, watching Adam Wathan's Refactoring to Collections course as well as <u>lessons on Laracasts</u>, I've become a fan of <u>Laravel's Illuminate Collections</u> and the object-orientated pipeline approach for interacting with PHP arrays.
